

NHS North Norfolk CCG were a suggestion regarding providing mental health services within Cromer Medical Centre.

The answer provided in a written response can be found below:

As you may be aware, the Norfolk and Waveney NHS Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) recently published a draft Adult Mental Health Strategy to improve mental health services in the area. This followed a long period of engagement with service users, carers, staff and other stakeholders.

Within the strategy is a vision to develop and deliver 'place based' services wrapped around primary care, through integrating mental and physical health in each of our local areas, which include Great Yarmouth & Waveney, Norwich Norfolk, Norwich, South Norfolk and West Norfolk.
